## RESEARCH DOCUMENTATION-MLA STYLE

(Do not use report cover sheet unless you are including a table of contents; your name, prof's name, section name, date in upper left corner on first page of text. See MLA manual for examples.)

**BIBLIOGRAPHY AND NOTE CARDS:** Enter research on 3X5 index card. Accurate and clear bibliographic information and quotations will save time when transferring information to the research paper.

**WORKING BIBLIOGRAPHY CARD:** Note how card references catalog number and data base.
